#### **JURISDICTION**

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2002).

#### **FACTS**

- 1. That Respondent, Knox County Landfill Committee, is the permitted owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, a facility located in rural Knox County, near Wataga, Illinois.
- 2. That Respondent, Greg Ingle, is the Certified Operator of the above-referenced facility.
- 3. That said facility is operated as a sanitary landfill, operating under Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit No. 1994-105-LFM, and is designated with Site Code No. 0958160003. The facility is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Knox County Landfill #3.
- 5. That Respondents have owned and/or operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.

6. That on May 26, 2004, Jeffrey Port of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-referenced facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

#### **VIOLATIONS**

Based upon direct observations made by Jeffrey Port during the course of his May 26, 2004 inspection of the above-referenced facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill operation in a manner which resulted in refuse in standing or flowing waters, a violation of Section 21(o)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(1) (2002).
- (2) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill operation in a manner which resulted in leachate flows entering waters of the state, a violation of Section 21(o)(2) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(2) (2002).
- (3) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill in a manner which resulted in uncovered refuse remaining from any previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, a violation of Section 21 (o)(5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21 (o)(5) (2002).
- (4) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill operation in a manner which resulted in the failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of each operating day, a violation of Section 21(o)(12) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(12) (2002).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4) (2002), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>August 13, 2004</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2002), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2002), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

## PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2002). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

#### Narrative

On May 26, 2004, I (Jeff Port) performed a Solid Waste Landfill Inspection at the Knox County Landfill #3 located in rural Knox County, near Wataga. The facility is an 814 Subpart C landfill with authorization under Permit #1994-105-LFM issued on September 29, 1994. The most recent modification, #19 was issued on November 19, 2003.

I arrived at the site at 5:25 AM. I was accompanied by Dawn Ingold, DLPC/FOS Peoria. The entrance gate to the facility was locked but the exit gate was open, so we proceeded through the exit gate. We went to the office but the door was locked. We then went to the maintenance building. Someone was working under one of the vehicles. I asked if Mr. Ingle was present. The man under the vehicle said that he was not. I introduced myself and explained that I needed to perform an inspection. I asked the man where the previous day's active area was. The man directed me to the active area. We then proceeded to this area.

Photographs P1 through P5 show the previous day's active area located in Cell 3. Uncovered refuse can be seen here. Photographs P6 through P8 were taken around the perimeter of Cell 3. Photographs P9 and P10 show the northern perimeter of Cells 4/5. After examining this area, we went to Cells 1/2.

Photograph P11 shows the eastern slope of Cells 1/2. Photographs P12 through P15 show uncovered refused present in erosion ruts on the eastern edge of Cells 1/2. Photograph P16 shows leachate present in one of the erosion ruts. Photographs P17 through P19 were taken at the southeast corner of Cells 1/2 and show the area looking toward the southeast, north, and west respectively. Photograph P20 taken near the junction of Cells 1/2 and 4/5 show the site looking toward the west.

Photographs P21 and P22 show erosion ruts with exposed refuse on the eastern border of Cells 4/5. Photograph P23 taken near the northern border of Cells 4/5 show this area looking toward the southwest. Photograph P24 shows a pile of waste on the northern border of Cell 4/5. After photographing the active portion of the landfill, we proceeded to the newly developed Cell 9 where I performed a Pre-operational Inspection.

Photographs P25 through P28, P30, P31, P36, and P37 show exposed waste on the southeast corner of Cell 9. At this location, Cell 9 intersects with Cells 4/5. Waste has been sloughing off from this area into the new unpermitted cell. Leachate has also been generated in this area as water comes into contact with the waste and runs down into the new cell. Leachate has accumulated in this area and can be seen in the photographs. Photograph P29 shows vegetation growing on the sand layer of Cell 9. Photographs P32 through P34 taken from the eastern edge of Cell 9 show the cell looking toward the west. Photograph P35 shows the eastern edge of the new cell looking toward the north, from the southeast corner. Photographs P38 through P40 were taken from the southwest corner of Cell 9. Several areas of ponding were present here. Photographs P41 through P44 were taken at the northwest corner of Cell 9. Blown litter from the active area can be seen in standing water here. Drainage problems appear to be present in this

area, as leachate had flowed over the berm and down the side of the cell, impacting the waters of the state. Sand had also washed away in this area, exposing the liner. It does not appear that Cell 9 is in a condition to accept waste. After examining and photographing this area, an inspection was performed on Knox County Landfill #2 and the Compost facility. Those inspections are under their own covers.

Mr. Ingle had joined us during the inspection for site #2. We went to the office were I reviewed facility records. Mr. Ingle stated that the compactor had caught on fire on May 12 and that the load checks had been stored inside it. He sent one of the employees to the compactor to retrieve the load checks. He said that the facility was operating as best as it could without the compactor, by driving over the waste to help compact it. I examined the load checks that were brought back to the office. I also examined the load checks that had been logged in after the fire. These items appeared to be in order. After further discussion with Mr. Ingle, we left the site at 9:05 AM.

Photograph locations are depicted on the accompanying site map. Based upon this inspection, the following violations were observed and are indicated on the accompany checklist.

- 1. Pursuant to Section 12(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/12(a)), no person shall cause or threaten or allow the discharge of any contaminants into the environment in any State so as to cause or tend to cause water pollution in Illinois, either alone or in combination with matter from other sources, or so as to violate regulations or standards adopted by the Pollution Control Board under this Act.
  - A violation of Section 12(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/12(a)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, allowed the discharge of leachate so as to cause water pollution.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 12(d) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/12(d)), no person shall deposit any contaminants upon the land in such place and manner so as to create a water pollution hazard.
  - A violation of Section 12(d) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/12(d)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, allowed the discharge of leachate onto the land so as to create a water pollution hazard.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit granted by the Agency or in violation of any conditions imposed by such permit.

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) is alleged for the following reasons: Knox County as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3 failed to comply with the following conditions of Permit Number 1994-105-LFM.

#### II. Operating Conditions

- 2. The operator of this solid waste facility shall not conduct the operation in a manner which results in any of the following.
  - a. Refuse in standing or flowing waters;
  - b. Leachate flows entering waters of the State;
  - e. Uncovered refuse remaining from any previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, unless authorized by permit;
  - i. Deposition of refuse in any unpermitted (i.e., without an Illinois EPA approved significant modification authorizing operation) portion of the landfill;
  - I. Failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of each operating day;
- 4. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(2)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.
  - A violation of Section 21(d)(2) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, conducted a waste-disposal operation in violation of Sections 811.106(a) and 811.107(k) of the Regulations.
- 5. Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)), no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, conducted a waste-disposal operation in violation of Sections 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e), 21(o)(1), 21(o)(2), 21(o)(5), 21(o)(9), and 21(o)(12) of the Act and Sections 811.106(a) and 811.107(k) of the Regulations.

6. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(1)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in refuse in standing or flowing waters.

A violation of Section 21(o)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(1)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, caused or allowed the accumulation of refuse in standing waters.

7. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(2)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in leachate flows entering waters of the State.

A violation of Section 21(0)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(0)(2)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, caused or allowed leachate from Cell 9 to enter the waters of the state.

8. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(5) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(5)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in uncovered refuse remaining from any previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, unless authorized by permit.

A violation of Section 21(0)(5) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(0)(5)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to provide daily cover to the site.

9. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(9) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(9)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in deposition of refuse in any unpermitted portion of the landfill.

A violation of Section 21(0)(9) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(0)(9)) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, allowed the deposition of refuse in Cell 9, an unpermitted portion of the landfill.

10. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(12) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(12)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of each operating day.



11. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.106(a), a uniform layer of at least 0.15 meter (six inches) of clean soil material shall be placed on all exposed waste by the end of each day of operation.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.106(a) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to provide daily cover to the site.

12. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.107(k), the operator shall patrol the facility daily to check for litter accumulation. All litter shall be collected and placed in the fill or in a secure, covered container for later disposal.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.107(k)(1) is alleged for the following reason: Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to check for litter accumulation and ensure that the litter is either placed in the fill or in a secure, covered container for later disposal.
