- 1. On September 12, 2002, Perfetti Van Melle filed a Petition for Review of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's decision on May 7, 2002 to deny the Petitioner's Application for a Lifetime Operating Permit. On September 19, 2002 the Board issued an Order accepting the Petition for hearing.
