

HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On February 16, 2005, the complainant informed the hearing office that it anticipates that it will file a stipulation and proposal for settlement (stipulation) with the Board within 14 days.

At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. If, however, a stipulation is filed before the next status conference, the conference will be cancelled without further order.
