
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

On March 3, 1994, H.C.T.K. Inc. filed a petition for review of an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) final underground storage tank (UST) Fund reimbursement decision. In order for the Board to review an Agency final determination pursuant to Sections 22.18(b)(g) and 40 of the Environmental Protection Act (Act), a petition for review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of the final determination. (415 ILCS 5/22.18b(g), 5/40 (1992).) H.C.T.K.'s petition indicates only that the Agency issued an invoice voucher on January 14, 1994 accompanied by Attachment A which contains the stated reasons for deductions. Thus, a question remains whether this appeal is timely-filed.

H.C.T.K. is directed to amend its petition, within forty-five (45) days of the date of this order, to include sufficient information to determine whether this petition is properly before the Board pursuant to Sections 22.18(b)(g) and 40 of the Act. Failure to do so will subject this matter to dismissal.
