



DISSENTING OPINION (by J. Theodore Meyer):


I dissent from the majority opinion in this case for the same reasons set forth in Mr. Nardulli and my dissent in Harlem Township v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (October 16, 1992), PCB 92-83. In short, I believe that a release from a pump nozzle is the type of release intended to be included in the definition of "underground storage tank." Therefore, I would have allowed reimbursement.

For these reasons, I dissent.
