This matter is before the Board on a January 12, 1995 status report filed by petitioner Moline/Dutchway Dry Cleaners (Dutchway). Dutchway states that in mid-December the petitioner's counsel consulted with the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM). The petitioner anticipates submitting additional documents to OSFM for review of the site's eligibility for UST Fund reimbursement.
