ORDER OF THE BOARD (by E. Dunham):


This matter comes before the Board on a "Motion for Extension of Stay" filed on April 25, 1995. On February 23, 1995 the Board granted a stay in this matter until April 18, 1995.

The parties report that a stipulation and proposal for settlement was signed and returned to complainant by Beloit Corporation (Beloit). However, the settlement document that was sent to All States Asbestos Professionals (All States) was returned by the United States Post Office as undelivered. Despite a diligent search by complaint, All States has not been located. The settlement document needed to be redrafted deleting All States since the original settlement agreement was written for all parties. The redrafted document was sent to Beloit for signing on March 17, 1995. Complainant requests that the stay be extended for an additional thirty days to provide the necessary time to obtain all necessary signatures.

The Board grants the motion for extension of stay. The stay will expire on June 2, 1995.
