ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. C. Marlin):

On February 1, 1993, a joint status report was filed in this matter pursuant to a December 17, 1992, Board order and a November 20, 1992, hearing officer order. The status report was filed jointly by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and the Illinois Environmental Regulatory Group (IERG). Additionally, the status report states that IERG has spoken to the Sierra Club which concurs with the status report.


The status report states that IERG has circulated a draft proposal (draft) for reporting requirements which has been received by both the Agency and the Sierra Club. Despite the fact that the Agency has not yet thoroughly reviewed the draft, the Agency reports that it believes the draft will form the basis for negotiation of source reporting requirements.

The Agency and IERG also state in the status report that they believe additional time is needed to complete negotiations and that the draft will be helpful in expediting negotiations. The Agency and IERG do not believe that a hearing would be useful at this time in reaching a consensus. Finally, the Agency and IERG ask that the next status report be due no earlier than May 15, 1993.

The Board believes that it is in the best interest of everyone involved to allow the interested parties time to negotiate before proceeding to hearing in this matter. Therefore, the Board will not order the hearing officer to set a hearing date at this time. The Board and the hearing officer will determine the timing and sequence of further actions in this docket upon the receipt of the next status report. The Board hereby orders the parties to file their next status report on or before May 15, 1993.
