The Board entered a final Opinion and Order in this matter on April 9, 1992, and a Supplemental Opinion and Order on May 21, 1992. This Order corrects minor typographical errors discovered in preparing the final rules for publication and filing.

The following typographical errors in the April 9, 1992, Order in this matter have been corrected prior to filing the adopted rules with the Administrative Code Division. In order to highlight the corrections, in this first list striking and underlining refer to the proposed text rather than the base text.


