
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

On September 22, 1992, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a motion requesting the hearing officer to grant it leave to file a supplemental answer and affirmative defense in this matter. The Agency also filed a memorandum in support of the motion. On September 23, 1992, Lori Prokes Davis, one of the attorneys for Reichhold Chemicals, Inc. (Reichhold) filed a motion to withdraw her appearance and an accompanying withdrawal of appearance.

The Board notes that, on September 21, 1992, it granted an August 25, 1992 motion to strike that was filed by Reichhold. In granting the motion, the Board struck the same affirmative defense that was previously asserted by the Agency in its July 31, 1992 answer in this matter. Accordingly, the Agency's current motion is moot. The Board, however, grants the motion to withdraw.
