

to file the record within 21 days of the date of that order, i.e. on or before February 10, 1994. The record has not yet been filed.

The Board reminds the Village that failure to timely file the record may subject it to sanctions. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 107, and Zeman et al. v. Village of Summit et al., PCB 92-174 and PCB 92-177 (consolidated), Order of January 7, 1993. The Board on its own motion, will grant the Village an extension of time to file through February 24, 1994.
