ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. C. Marlin):

This matter comes before the Board on receipt of a Motion to File Certificate of Acceptance Instanter filed by Commonwealth Edison Co. on December 4, 1992. The Board has not received an Agency response.

The Board granted Commonwealth Edison a provisional variance on November 19, 1992 upon the November 18, 1992 receipt of an Agency recommendation. That order required Commonwealth Edison to complete and file a Certificate of Acceptance within 10 days (by November 30, 1992 because November 29 was a Sunday). The motion to file states that Commonwealth Edison did not timely file the Certificate because it did receive a copy of the Board's order.

The Board hereby grants Commonwealth Edison's motion to file instanter. We are aware that for reasons we have not yet identified, a few persons did not timely receive copies of orders issued during our November 19, 1992 meeting.
