
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On July 15, 1996, the Office of the Attorney General, on behalf of the People of the State of Illinois (People), filed a complaint against White & Brewer Trucking. On June 9, 2005, the People filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the People assert that proceedings in another forum are being initiated to address the alleged violations at this facility. To date, no response to the motion has been received by the Board.

If a party files no response to a motion within 14 days the party will be deemed to have waived objection to the granting of the motion. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d). The motion is granted. The Board hereby dismisses the complaint, and closes the docket.
