

MOTION TO POSTPONE HEARING


COMES NOW, RESPONDENT JEFFREY S. GRELYAK, by his attorney George W. Tinkham, and moves Illinois Pollution Control Board Hearing Officer Bradley P. Halloran to postpone the hearing in this matter now scheduled to be held on 25 January 2006. In support of this Motion, George Tinkham states as follows:

1. After numerous communications between Mr. Tinkham and Jeremy Shaw, attorney for Complainant, it appears there is substantial potential for an agreement between the parties.
2. To work out an agreed resolution of this matter, additional draft proposals need to be reviewed by the parties. Also, a face-to-face meeting is being planned.
3. The details outlined in #2 above take time, and there is not enough time between now and January 25<sup>th</sup> both to engage in settlement efforts and to prepare for trial.
4. Jeremy Shaw has informed George Tinkham that he (Jeremy Shaw) does not oppose this request to postpone the hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESPONDENT asks that the hearing now scheduled in this matter on 25 January 2006 be postponed until it is clear that all attempts at settlement have been exhausted. The parties should know by 31 January 2006 if they will settle or if this should go to trial.
