
ORDER OF THE BOARD BY (J. Anderson):

This matter comes before the Board on the January 22, 1990 Agency response to December 20, 1989 Board Order. The Board issued a default order to the respondent in this matter on October 18, 1989. The respondent filed a motion to vacate the default order on December 11, 1989. In support of his motion, respondent claims that service was defective. The Agency response did not contest respondent's assertion.

After considering both the motion to vacate and the response, the Board believes that there is just cause to vacate its Default Order of October 18, 1989. The Clerk is directed to set this matter for hearing. In addition, the Clerk is to attach, for the respondent's information, sections 21(p), 21(q), 31.1, 32, and 42(b)(4) of the Environmental Protection Act.
