ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On January 13, 2006, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Vic Koenig Chevrolet may appeal a December 12, 2005 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.402, 105.406. The Agency denied the request for reimbursement of certain costs of corrective action for Vic Koenig Chevrolet's leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at 1040 East Main Street, Carbondale, Jackson County.

The Board extends the appeal period until April 17, 2006, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Vic Koenig Chevrolet fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
