### Order of the Board:

In response to your order submitted May 18, 2006, I AM submitting the following response:

On March 2, 2005, a representative from the IEPA office visited the job site which I was working on at the Carterville Elementary School. This job was contracted to Freeman Environmental of Herrin, Illinois & I was an operator<sup>on</sup> the job. At that time, all of the demolition wood debris had been taken away & hauled to the landfill, with proper receipts. All that remained was some partial concrete footings.

Earlier that day, school authorities advised us that it was mandatory that we have the basement completely filled with dirt, or that the beginning of the school year would be delayed & the children could not start school on time. In order to facilitate this, I agreed to try to help by taking the concrete to my property, so that school could start on Monday.

I was not aware that I was violating any laws, and after working Saturday + Sunday, hauling 115 loads, the job was completed, allowing school to begin as scheduled.

I was informed several days later that I should not have dumped this concrete without a permit. Subsequently I applied for a permit, but was denied because I inadvertently left out required information on the application. In photograph #12, I complied with all requests and completed the cleanup, submitting landfill receipts. I have reapplied for the permit, (see enclosed copy)

I AM continuing to complete the cleanup process + request the additional time to do so.

## Application for Interim Authorization for Clean Construction or Demolition Debris Fill Operations (LPC-PA24)

This form must be used to apply for interim authorization for clean construction or demolition debris fill operations pursuant to Section 22.51 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act. Interim authorization is required only for sites where clean construction or demolition debris is being used as fill in a current or former quarry, mine, or other excavation. This application is not required for clean construction or demolition debris recycling sites, active mining operations, or permitted landfills unless clean construction or demolition debris is being used as fill at the site in a current or former quarry, mine, or other excavation.

V. CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE \*

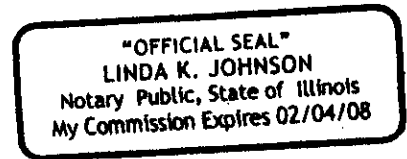

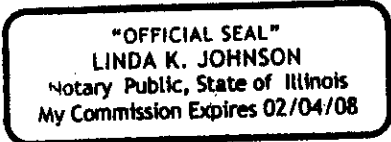
