Our company is writing you in regards to: In the Matter of Amendments to the Board's Special Waste Rules Concerning Used Oil, 35 III. Adm. Code 808, 809, RC 06-20.

Thank you for this opportunity to provide public comment in the above-referenced rulemaking. I submit this comment on behalf of Solvent Systems International (SSI), a member of NORA. SSI picks up used oil from many of our customers for recycling. Our customers and SSI believe that this recycling effort not only helps our customer's businesses but also helps the environment as well as conserves valuable petroleum resources. SSI endorses and supports NORA's rule proposal and requests that the Board adopt the language proposed by NORA.

Special Waste manifesting for used oil, including those substances entitled to be regulated as used oil pursuant to federal and state regulations, is burdensome and unnecessary.

In closing, our company believes that the current manifesting requirements in Illinois for Used Oil and items regulated as Used Oil are unnecessary and burdensome. We strongly encourage the Board to adopt the language proposed by NORA. We look forward to the Board's adoption of NORA's rule proposal.
