ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Nardulli):


This matter comes before the Board on a Motion for Modification of Order and Leave to file Motion Instanter filed October 26, 1989 by Petitioner, Joliet Army Ammunition Plant.

Petitioner states that because of poor communication between itself and U.S. Army Armament, Munitions and Chemical Command, it was unable to obtain the information necessary to its Motion for Modification of Variance Order within the 35-day reconsideration period. Petitioner also states that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) has no objection to the proposed modifications.

Petitioner is hereby allowed to file its Motion for Modification Instanter. However, the substance of the Motion for Modification will not be ruled upon until the Agency's response time has expired.
