

HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On March 29, 2007, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties represented that they are still exploring avenues for settlement. At the request of the parties, the discovery schedule has been revised. Responses to written interrogatories and requests for production must be served on or before April 18, 2007. Parties must review written discovery and advise responding parties of any deficiencies on or before May 2, 2007. Parties must confer in person or by telephone any disputes over written discovery.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on May 10, 1:30 p.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. The complainant represented that it will notify the parties and the hearing officer of a call-in number prior to the next telephonic status conference. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


