
DISSENTING OPINION (by J. Theodore Meyer):

The original rulemaking in this matter sought to make Illinois law uniform with Missouri law, which resulted in more relaxed air emissions regulations. Although the amendments in the present matter involve only a one month period of leniency for certain facilities, I am opposed to relaxing any air emissions regulations, and on that principle I respectfully dissent.
