

Petitioner Illinois-American Water Company ("Illinois-American"), by its attorney Alison M. Nelson, hereby submits the certificate of publication of the legal notice required by 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.408 in connection with the above-captioned matter. In support of this SUBMISSION OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLICATION IN AS 2007-2, Illinois-American states as follows:

1. On April 2, 2007, Illinois-American filed its AMENDED PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF ADJUSTED STANDARD in AS 2007-2.
2. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.408, Illinois-American caused publication of a notice beginning on April 16, 2007 and ending April 19, 2007 in The Telegraph, a newspaper published in the city of Alton, county of Madison, and state of Illinois, and of general circulation throughout said county, in which Illinois-American's public water supply treatment facility (the "Alton facility") is located.
3. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.410 requires Illinois-American to file with the Board within 30 days after the filing of the petition a certificate of publication issued by the publisher of the petition notice in accordance with Section 1 of the Notice by Publication Act [715 ILCS 5/1] certifying the publication of that notice.
4. Section 1 of the Notice by Publication Act requires the certificate of the publisher to include a written or printed copy of the notice, a statement of the number of times which the notice was published, and a statement of the dates of the first and last papers containing the notice. The attached certificate of publication was issued by The Telegraph in accordance with these requirements.

WHEREFORE, Illinois-American respectfully submits this SUBMISSION OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLICATION IN AS 2007-2.

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Drive, Belleville, IL 62223, filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board an amended petition for extension of an adjusted standard. The amended petition supersedes Illinois-American Water's petition filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board on October 31, 2006. The Board Docket Number assigned to this proceeding is AS 2007-2.

Illinois-American Water owns and operates a public water supply treatment facility in Alton, Illinois (the "Alton facility"). The Alton facility, located on Illinois Route 100 near River Mile 204 of the Mississippi River, withdraws water from the River, clarifies and filters the river water, and discharges to the River effluent containing iron and sediments present in the river water and residuals from coagulants added during treatment. The discharges are done under the authority of an adjusted standard granted by the Board in 2000, known as AS 99-6. AS 99-6 will expire on October 16, 2007. By its amended petition, Illinois-American Water seeks an extension to

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AS 99-6 from the effluent standards for offensive discharges (35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.106), total suspended solids (35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.124), and total iron (35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.124).

Illinois-American Water's proposed adjusted standard will, like AS 99-6, provide that the effluent standards at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.106, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.124, and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.124 shall not apply to discharges from the Alton facility. The proposed adjusted standard will be conditioned on Illinois-American Water's continued compliance with its contract with Great Rivers Land Trust for implementation of the Piasa Creek Watershed Project (a project that reduces the amount of sediment entering streams in the Piasa Creek Watershed and, ultimately, the Mississippi), and its entry into a contract for maintenance of the soil savings achieved by that Project. The proposed adjusted standard will last indefinitely, and will expire if the Board determines that the conditions of the Mississippi have changed such that the

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adjusted standard is obsolete or infeasible, or if the amount of soil saved does not offset the amount of solids in the Alton facility's effluent by 2 to 1, (based on an average of the calendar year in question and the four preceding years), or if the amount of soil saved diminishes below 6,600 tons per year.

Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described adjusted standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the adjusted standard proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
