TAKE NOTICE: On July 24, 2007, the Illi-nois Department of Transportation
("IDOT") submitted a petition to the Illinois Pollution Control Board Pollution Control Board ("IPCB") for an adiusted standard from 35 Illinois Administrative Code (III. Adm. Code) 302.208 for sulfates and total dissolved solids. The initial filing of the petition was received by the IPCB on July 27, 2007, and issued Case Number AS 2008-001. In orber AS 2008-001. In or-der to prevent flooding and structural damage to the Interstate High-way system in the East St. Louis area groundwater levels are kept pumped down by four separate ground-water pumping sys-tems. Three of the systems discharge to the IDOT District 8 the IDOT District & Bowman Avenue Pump Station ('Bowman'), located at Bowman Avenue and Exchange Avenue, where they are pumped to a discharge sewer. The Bowman Pumping system discharges to an unamed drainage way, thence to Schoenberger Creek and thence to Cahokia Canal. The discharge is regulated to Cahokia Canal. The discharge is regulated by effluent standards from 35 III. Adm. Code 304 and an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency National Polylutant Discharge and Elimination System. Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Due to the naturally occur-ring concentrations of ring concentrations of the various parameters, the groundwater pumped from the well systems may cause exceedences of water quality standards as set forth in 35 III. Adm. Code 302.208. The groundwater in this system is not known to have been contaminated by any human activity. activity.

The NPDES Permit requires the discharge waters meet parame-ter effluent limits that are derived from water quality limits. The sulfate constituent may have occasionally and the total dissolved solthe total dissolved sol-ids (TDS) parameter has foutfinely exceeded the respective permit-ted NPDES effluent limits. Therefore, IDOT seeks an ad-justed standard for sulfates and TDS.
