PETITION FOR REVIEW OF ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY DECISION

Big Tony's Lounge, by its attorney, Carolyn S. Hesse of Barnes & Thornburg, pursuant to the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq. (the "Act") and 35 Illinois Administrative Code Section 105.400 et. seq., hereby appeals certain decisions by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (the "Agency").

- 1. Big Tony's Lounge ("Petitioner"), is the owner of property located on Route 51 North, Cairo, Alexander County, Illinois. The site had underground storage tanks (USTs) on the property, which stored gasoline.
- LUST Incident Number 20020881 was obtained. The site has also been assigned LPC #0030055049-Alexander County.
- On March 21, 2007, the Agency received a Corrective Action Plan Budget (the "Budget") dated March 21, 2007.
- 4. By letter dated May 10, 2007, the Agency rejected the proposed Budget.

 (Exhibit 1.) Petitioner is appealing the Agency's decisions in the Letter dated May 10, 2007.

- 5. On June 14, 2007, a joint notice to extend the 35-day appeal period was filed with the Board to allow the parties additional time to try to resolve the issues and, on June 21, 2007, the Board extended the appeal period until September 11, 2007. Accordingly, this appeal is timely filed.
- 6. The Agency's denial of the proposed budget as stated in Item 2 of the Letter exceeds the Agency's authority under Part 734 because the Agency requires the submission of information that is not required to be submitted under the applicable regulations.
- 7. Even though the parties have had discussions and believe that they may still be able to resolve the issues raised in the Letter, such resolution will not be reached by the deadline for filing this appeal. Accordingly, Petitioner is filing this appeal of the Letter.

WHEREFORE, Big Tony's Lounge respectfully requests that the Board enter an order requiring the Agency to approve the Corrective Action Plan Budget for Big Tony's Lounge and for Petitioner's attorneys' fees and costs in bringing this appeal.

Dear Mr. Thompson:

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the Corrective Action Plan Budget (budget) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This budget, dated March 21, 2007, was received by the Illinois EPA on March 21, 2007. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act), as amended by Public Act 92-0554 on June 24, 2002, and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

The budget is rejected for the reason(s) listed below (Sections 57.7(b) and 57.7(c) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.505(b), 734.510(a) and 734.510(b)).

- The budget includes costs that lack supporting documentation. Such costs are ineligible 1. for payment from the Fund pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.630(cc). Since there is no supporting documentation of costs, the Illinois EPA cannot determine that costs will not be used for activities in excess of those necessary to meet the minimum requirements of Title XVI of the Act therefore, such costs are not approved pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(3) of the Act because they may be used for site investigation or corrective action activities in excess of those required to meet the minimum requirements of Title XVI of the Act.
- The budget includes corrective action costs for Excavation, Transportation, Disposal and 2. Backfill that are not reasonable as submitted. Such costs are ineligible for payment from the Fund pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(3) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.630(dd).

A detailed time and materials cost breakdown is required from each bidder to demonstrate they are qualified and able to perform the work being bid pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 734.855(a). This information should include a time and materials breakdown of all subcontractors costs as well.

3. The budget includes costs requested that are based on mathematical errors. Such costs are ineligible for payment from the Fund pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.630(bb). In addition, such costs are not approved pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(3) of the Act because they are not reasonable.

Based on a April 17, 2007 telephone conversation between Dave Myers of the Illinois EPA and Jeff Wienhoff of CW3M, postage associated with distribution of a reimbursement claim should have been \$5.00 rather than \$8500.00.

4. The budget includes site investigation or corrective action costs for latex gloves that are not reasonable as submitted. Such costs are ineligible for payment from the Fund pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(3) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.630(dd).

Costs associated with disposable latex gloves (\$12.00) appear twice under Consultant's Material Costs.

Pursuant to Sections 57.7(b) and 57.12(c) and (d) of the Act and 35 III. Adm. Code 734.100 and 734.125, a budget must be submitted within 30 days of the date of this letter to:



Appeal Rights

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
