THERE WAS A LOT OF BLACK DUST FOUND AS THE PICTURES SHOW. I AM ALSO INCLUDING SEVERAL MORE PHOTO'S WITH DATES AND DESCRIPTIONS OF WHERE OR WHAT THEY ARE. I AM INCLUDING A PORTION OF A JOURNAL I WAS KEEPING DESCRIBING WHAT IT HAS BEEN LIKE LIVING NEXT TO THIS MINE ON A DAY BY DAY BASIS.

FOR 12a, 12b, & 12d, I AM INCLUDING A NOTICE OF VIOLATION FROM THE IDNR, OFFICE OF MINES&MINERALS # 37-5-05. I'M SURE THEY COULD GIVE YOU MORE EXAMPLES AS COULD THE IEPA [IF THEY WERE SO INSTRUCTED].

AS FOR 24, ALL I CAN SEND YOU NOW IS A COPY OF MY DAILY JOURNAL. MY NEIGHBORS HAVE TAKEN NOISE LEVELS AT THEIR HOMES BUT I DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO A NOISE METER. HOWEVER, I HAVE TAKEN A LOT OF VIDEO'S WHICH CLEARLY ALLOW A PERSON TO "SEE" AND "HEAR" THE VIOLATIONS OF NOISE POLLUTION THAT I HAVE TRIED TO DESCRIBE TO YOU. SCOTT ARNOLD OF THE MARION OFFICE OF IEPA HAS SEEN A PORTION OF ONE OF MY TAPES. I WOULD BE MORE THAN HAPPY TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR YOU TO VIEW THEM. HOWEVER, WHEN I SPOKE WITH [I believe] ACAROL WEBB OF THE IPCB, SHE SAID YOU HAD NO WAY TO VIEW IT. I WOULD BE GLAD TO TRY AND PUT IT ON A DVD IF THAT WILL HELP.

THE FOLLOWING IS: "JUST MY STATEMENT" !

I, GEORGE R. STRUNK, BELIEVE ALL THAT ALL I HAVE INCLUDED IN THIS PACKET TO BE CORRECT AND TRUE. IT IS MY BELIEF THAT THE IEPA WAS ESTABLISHED TO PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT. NOT THE POCKET-BOOK OF LARGE CORPORATIONS WHO WILFULLY DESTROY OUR ENVIRONMENT WITH AIR-NOISE AND WATER POLLUTION. THEY HAVE A HUGE BASE OF ATTORNEYS AND LEGAL COUNCIL TO ADVISE THEM HOW TO SLIP PAST THE REGULATIONS OF THE CLEAN AIR ACT. I, AS A PRIVATE CITIZEN MUST RELY ON THE SYSTEM AND HOPE THAT WE GET AN HONEST LOOK AT OUR COMPLAINTS. I HAVE REQUESTED OTHER DOCUMENTS, BUT THEY HAVE BEEN SLOW IN COMING. I CAN ONLY PRAY THAT YOU WILL TAKE A GOOD-HONEST LOOK AT WHAT I HAVE SENT.

Pursuant to 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1845.12, the Department is hereby assessing Steelhead Development Company a penalty of \$1,225.00. A copy of the assessment, worksheets showing the computation of the assessment and the Notice of Violation for which the penalty is being assessed are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Please note that pursuant to Section 1845.18(a), you are required to pay this amount to the Office of Mines and Minerals within thirty days of receipt of this assessment. If, within this thirty day period, your company notifies the Department in writing that it will contest this matter then this payment will be placed in an escrow account pending completion of the proceedings.

Pursuant to Section 1845.18(b), failure to forward the assessed amount to the Department within thirty days of receipt of the proposed penalty assessment shall result in a waiver of all legal rights to contest both the fact of the violation and the amount of the penalty.


1. Probability of occurrence: It was unlikely that the sediment basin would have had structural problems that would have caused a failure of the impoundment however, the water sample collected during this unauthorized discharge did reveal acidity greater than alkalinity and T.S.S. more three times the allowable limit. This drainage could eventually have an adverse affect on plant and animal life. Therefore, the higher value of \$200.00 was selected.

2. Extent of Damage: An impoundment failure did not occur however, the non-compliance drainage was allowed to extend outside of the permit area. As indicated, water samples confirmed a non-compliance discharge. Left unattended, future discharges could eventually have an adverse affect on the plant and animal life in receiving streams. Therefore the mid-range value of \$525.00 was selected.

B. Administrative:

III. Negligence: \$500.00 was selected as there were no compounding or mitigating circumstances that would justify a lesser value. The permittee had been made aware that the sediment ponds needed to be completed and as-built certifications submitted on the impoundments.

IV. Good Faith: No good faith effort was exhibited in abating this violation.

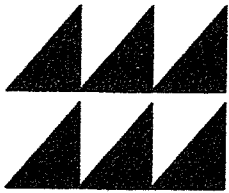

RE: Alleged Fugitive Coal Dust Complaint for Permit #375 on April 16, 2007

Mr. George Strunk, contacted Mach Mining, LLC, at 1:15 PM on April 16, 2007, alleging a cloud of fugitive coal dust migrating from the Pond Creek Mine's clean coal stacker and represented that this dust was causing damage to his and surrounding properties. He alleged that the dust cloud was occurring all morning and continuing at the time of his call to us at 1:15 PM.

We promptly proceeded to investigate his complaint. Our investigation revealed that on April 16, by coincidence, a NSPS Subpart Y – Opacity Performance Test was being performed by an independent certified consulting firm on all coal transfer infrastructure, which included the clean coal stacker. The inspection concluded that no non-compliant events had occurred on the property during the time of inspection. It may be of interest that the inspection of the clean coal stacking transfers point occurred during approximately 9:30 AM till 12:30 PM. The final report will be submitted in May 2007 to the IEPA- Division of Air Pollution Control in Springfield, IL.

Williamson's continual goal is to be in compliance with all requirements with regulatory agencies. Equally important is our commitment to the highest professional standards of operation and be a responsible neighbor in the community. However, we believe that Mr. Strunk's motives for his complaints are questionable and are tied directly to attempting to pressure Williamson Energy to purchase his property for an over inflated value.
