

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):

On August 6, 1990, the transcript of the hearing held on this matter and a copy of the executed Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement were filed with the Board. There is a discrepancy between the transcript, the complaint filed May 8, 1990, and the Stipulation. The description of the terms of the settlement in the transcript states: "Respondent admits to the past violations of Section 9(b) of the [Environmental Protection] Act." (Tr. p. 3-4). The complaint alleges violation of Section 9(b) of the Act. However the executed Stipulation provides that: "Respondent, Aggrecon, admits to the past violations of Section 9(a) and (b) of the Act." The Board directs the parties to file with the Board the proper pleading to clarify this issue; such pleading to be received by the Board by September 11, 1990.
