

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 10, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Prime Time Citgo, Inc. (Citgo) may appeal a May 16, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of Citgo's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 420 North Farnsworth, Aurora, Kane County. The Board extends the appeal period until September 18, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Citgo fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
