NOTICE OF LIMITED WAIVER OF 120-DAY DECISION DEADLINE

NOW COMES Petitioner, UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION (“Petitioner”), by and through its attorneys, HODGE DWYER & DRIVER, pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code § 101.308(c)(2), hereby agrees to a limited waiver of the statutory 120-day decision deadline for final action by the Illinois Pollution Control Board (“Board”) in this proceeding until May 20, 2010. In support of this Notice, Petitioner states as follows:

1. On October 7, 2009, Petitioner filed a Petition for Review (“Petition”) of the Clean Air Act Permit Program (“CAAPP”) permit (No. 96030056) (“Permit”) issued on September 3, 2009, by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“Illinois EPA”) for Petitioner’s integrated steel mill plant located in Granite City, Illinois.
2. On October 15, 2009, the Board accepted Petitioner’s Petition for hearing. Board Order, *United States Steel Corporation v. Illinois EPA*, PCB No. 10-23 (Ill.Pol.Control.Bd. Oct. 15, 2009). On December 3, 2009, the Board granted American

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Bottom Conservancy's Motion to Intervene. Board Order, *United States Steel Corporation v. Illinois EPA*, PCB No. 10-23 (Ill.Pol.Control.Bd. Dec. 3, 2009).

3. The current statutory decision deadline for this matter is April 15, 2010.

4. In order to continue to conduct settlement negotiations with the Illinois EPA in this matter, Petitioner hereby voluntarily agrees to a limited waiver of the statutory 120-day decision deadline until May 20, 2010.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, prays that the Illinois Pollution Control Board accept this limited waiver of the statutory 120-day decision deadline until May 20, 2010 for final action on Petitioner's Petition for Review.
