ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On July 1, 2010, Waste Management of Illinois (WMII) filed a motion asking the Board to sever these consolidated cases. The Board in a June 17, 2010 order consolidated these two cases and WMII asks that the Board sever the cases based on “the standards for consolidation and severance of claims articulated in Sections 101.406 and 101.408” of the Board’s rules. Mot. at 2, citing 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.406 and 101.408. WMII asserts that “in this case, the consolidation of WMII’s appeal with STMD’s [Stop the Mega-Dump] Third-Party appeal will not serve the interests of a convenient and expeditious determination of claims.” *Id.* WMII indicates that neither Stop the Mega-dump or DeKalb County objects to the motion to sever. Mot at 3.

The Board grants the motion to sever and directs the hearing officer to proceed with these cases as two separate dockets.
