
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On October 26, 2000, Marathon Ashland Petroleum (Marathon) filed a petition for variance regarding its petroleum refinery in Crawford County, Illinois. Marathon seeks a hearing on its request for variance from Sections 302.102(b)(6), 302.208, and 303.323(b) of the Board's water pollution regulations. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.102(b)(6), 302.208, 303.323(b). The Board accepts this matter for hearing.

Hearings shall be scheduled and completed in a timely manner pursuant to the applicable statutory decision deadline or as extended by waiver. The assigned hearing officer must inform the Clerk of the Board of the time and location of hearing at least 40 days in advance of hearing so that a 30-day public notice of hearing may be published. Unless otherwise ordered by the hearing officer, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency must file its recommendation for disposition of the petition within 30 days of the filing of this petition. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.180.
