**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECORD**

NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of the State of Illinois and, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116, moves the Hearing Officer for an extension of the time to file the record of its determination in this matter.

1. Petitioner, Van Zelst Landscape Composting Facility, filed its Amended Petition with the Board on October 4, 2010, with service directed to Illinois EPA in Springfield, Illinois. On October 25, 2010, Illinois EPA requested representation from the Illinois Attorney General's Officer. The undersigned filed his appearance on that same day.

2. On October 7, 2010, the Board directed that Illinois EPA's record of determination be filed on or before November 3, 2010, unless extended by the Board, or Hearing Officer.

3. Illinois EPA has begun accumulating all materials related to the relevant permit application. However, the Agency will not be able to file the complete record by the November 3, 2010 deadline.

4. Respondent therefore requests that the deadline for filing the record of determination in this matter be extended for fourteen (14) days, or until November 17, 2010. The undersigned suggests that this issue be discussed at the scheduled November 3, 2010 Hearing Officer status.


