REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECORD

NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of the State of Illinois and, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116, moves the Hearing Officer for an additional extension of the time to file the record of its determination in this matter. In support thereof, Respondent states as follows:

- 1. Petitioner, Van Zelst Landscape Composting Facility, filed its Amended Petition with the Board on October 4, 2010, with service directed to Illinois EPA in Springfield, Illinois. On October 7, 2010, the Board directed that Illinois EPA's record of determination be filed on or before November 3, 2010, unless extended by the Board, or Hearing Officer.
- 2. On November 3, 2010, the Hearing Officer granted Illinois EPA's request for an extension of the record filing deadline until November 17, 2010.
- 3. While Illinois EPA has substantially completed accumulating the record of its determination in this matter, the material needs to be reviewed for completeness.

 Respondent is concerned that this review may take more time than allowed by its former

extension request. Accordingly, Illinois EPA requests that the deadline be extended for an additional 13 days, or until November 30, 2010.

4. Petitioner has filed a waiver of the 90 day decision deadline, which has now been extended to May 2, 2010. Therefore, granting Respondent's request for an additional 13 days will not result in an undue burden on the Board.
