
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

On November 17, 1983 the City of Sycamore (City) filed a petition for variance which the Board found deficient pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.121 in that it failed to provide cost figures for alternative compliance methods, failed to include a schedule for reducing the infiltration and inflow to the City's sewer system, and included only a conclusory statement as to the environmental impact. On January 17, 1984 the City filed an amended petition in response to a Board Order of November 18, 1983 which noted those defects. However, that amended petition still fails to include a schedule for reducing inflow and infiltration.

Unless the City files an amended petition within 45 days of the date of this Order curing the above-noted defect, the petition will be subject to dismissal.
