**11-29** <u>Wildcat Farms, LLC - Dallas City (Propety ID No. 05-28-300-004)</u> – Upon receipt of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's recommendation, the Board found and certified that specified facilities of Wildcat Farms, LLC - Dallas City located in Hancock County are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2008)).</u>

**11-30** <u>Newcomer Confinements, Inc. - Lamark (Property ID No. 07-09-14-200-002) v.</u> <u>IEPA</u>– Upon receipt of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's recommendation, the Board found and certified that specified facilities of Newcomer Confinements, Inc. - Lamark located in Carroll County are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2008)).
