MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA

Now comes Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and requests that the Hearing Officer quash the discovery deposition subpoena of George Kennedy. In support of its request, Respondent states, as follows:

- 1. Petitioner KCBX Terminals Company ("KCBX") filed this permit appeal with the Board on February 1, 2011, and has demanded an early hearing. Despite the expedited schedule, Petitioner has served an overwhelming number of discovery requests upon Illinois EPA. On March 15, 2011, Respondent filed a motion to extend the deadline for responding to Petitioner's written discovery, which consists, inter alia, of nineteen pages of requests to admit facts. Unsurprisingly, Petitioner has responded by objecting to any extension.
- 2. KCBX has named former Illinois EPA Permit Engineer George Kennedy as a witness in its case. Mr. Kennedy retired from the Agency in December, 2010, but has been retained by the Agency on a part time basis. However this retention will expire by the end of April, 2011. Moreover, Mr. Kennedy will be out of the country on the date of hearing, June 1, 2011.
 - 3. On March 24, 2011, KCBX served the undersigned with two deposition subpoenas

for Mr. Kennedy (See: Exhibit A), both for April 14, 2011. The subpoenas seek to compel Mr. Kennedy to appear for a 3 hour 'discovery' deposition at 9:00 a.m., and then return for a second 3 hour 'evidence' deposition at 1:00 p.m.

- 4. KCBX had requested that the undersigned waive the 3 hour deposition limit contained in Section 101.622(f) of the Board Procedural Rules. Because the factual issues in this case are not complicated, and to prevent harassment and abuse of Illinois EPA employees, Respondent has rejected this request. Petitioner's attempt to 'double up' on Mr. Kennedy by subpoening him for two depositions on the same day is nothing but an attempt to circumvent the Board's deposition limitation.
- 5. Mr. Kennedy will be out of the country on June 1, 2011, thus satisfying the criteria for admissibility contained in Supreme Court Rule 212(b). Therefore Respondent does not object to an evidence deposition of Mr. Kennedy. However, taking an evidence deposition and a discovery deposition in the same day is nothing but harassment. Respondent therefore requests that the Hearing Officer limit Petitioner to one deposition of no more than three hours duration.


