
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

On February 19, 1985 the Hearing Officer in this proceeding ruled that a post-hearing briefing schedule was unnecessary. The Respondent has moved the Board to overrule the Hearing Officer on the basis that the issues presented in the case are complex and involve matters of law that have not yet been decided.

The Board would like to see additional legal argument in this case, but believes the briefing schedule proposed by Respondent is over long. The Board notes that it requested by Board Order on January 10, 1985 additional legal argument be presented at hearing. Apparently, this was not done. Therefore the Board will establish an expedited briefing schedule to allow the parties to supplement their legal arguments at this point. The Complainant will be allowed until March 28, 1985 to file its brief; the Respondent will be allowed until April 11, 1985 to file its brief; and the Complainant will be allowed until April 25, 1985 to file its response to Respondent's brief. Thereafter, the record in this proceeding shall be considered closed.
