1 MR. FOX: Good afternoon. Welcome  
2 to this Illinois Pollution Control Board hearing.  
3 My name is Tim Fox and I'm the Hearing Officer for  
4 this rulemaking proceeding entitled In The Matter  
5 of: Setback Zone for Fayette Water Company  
6 Community Water Supply. Amendments to 35 Ill.  
7 Adm. Code 618.

8 The Board Docket Number for this  
9 rulemaking is R11-25. I want to take a moment to  
10 indicate those who are present from the Board  
11 today. To my immediate right is Board Member  
12 Andrea Moore, who is the lead Board Member for  
13 this rulemaking, and to my immediate left is Dr.  
14 G. Tanner Girard who is the acting chairman of the  
15 Board. In addition to Dr. Girard's left is Board  
16 member Thomas Johnson. To his left is Board  
17 Member Carrie Zalewski and to Member Moore's right  
18 is Board Member Jennifer Burke.

19 I also want to point out that in  
20 the rear corner of the room are Anand Rao and  
21 Alisa Liu of the Board's technical staff. The  
22 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency initiated  
23 this rulemaking by filing a proposal on April 21st  
24 of 2011. In an order dated May 5th, 2011, the

1 Board accepted this proposal for hearing. The  
2 first hearing took place on July 27th, 2011, in  
3 Vandalia in Fayette County and on August 2nd,  
4 2011, a Hearing Officer order scheduled this  
5 second hearing and set a deadline of September  
6 8th, 2011, to pre-file testimony for it. However,  
7 no participant has pre-filed testimony for this  
8 hearing.

9                   Since the Board has received no  
10 pre-filed testimony, we would begin this hearing  
11 with the testimony of any person who had not  
12 pre-filed, but wishes to testify today. I do want  
13 to note for the record that Mr. Mark Mitchell is  
14 present here today on behalf of the Illinois Rural  
15 Water Association although he has indicated that  
16 he does not have testimony or comments that he  
17 wishes to offer. We would certainly offer him the  
18 opportunity at some point if he wishes to  
19 reconsider that to offer such testimony or  
20 comment.

21                   I do want to note also for the  
22 record that inside the door on the table is a  
23 sheet on which anyone may indicate that they would  
24 like to testify today, but I can see plainly that

1 no one has so indicated. What we will plan to do  
2 today is to make available to the Agency as the  
3 proponent of this proposal an opportunity to offer  
4 any additional testimony or comments that they may  
5 wish to offer in support of their proposal.

6 After they have done so or  
7 perhaps reflected that they do not wish to do so,  
8 we will go briefly off the record to allow anyone  
9 who may be delayed in arriving here today the  
10 opportunity to arrive.

11 At the conclusion of any  
12 testimony, we will certainly accept public comment  
13 as time allows before we adjourn the hearing in  
14 the event that anyone wishes to offer such a  
15 comment. As with all Board rulemaking  
16 proceedings, this proceeding is governed by the  
17 Board's procedural rules. Under Section 104.426  
18 of those rules, all information that is relevant  
19 and that is not repetitious or privileged will be  
20 admitted into the record.

21 Please note that any questions  
22 posed today by the Board or any of its staff  
23 members are intended solely to assist in  
24 developing a clear and complete record for the

1 Board's decision and do not reflect any  
2 prejudice or predetermination on the proposal.

3 I would ask for the benefit of  
4 the court reporter -- I don't think we'll have  
5 issues with sound amplification here, but if you  
6 would speak as clearly as possible and avoid  
7 speaking at the same time as any other person  
8 we'll have a much clearer record.

9 Any questions about our  
10 procedures going forward? Neither seeing nor  
11 hearing any, Ms. Olson, on behalf of the Agency  
12 why don't I introduce you just for a moment so  
13 that you may for the record let us know who is  
14 here on behalf of the Agency and at that point let  
15 us know if you have any testimony or comment with  
16 which you would like to supplement what is already  
17 in the record today.

18 MS. OLSON: Thank you. My name is  
19 Joanne Olson. I'm assistant counsel for the  
20 Illinois EPA and with me here today is Lynn  
21 Dunaway who is in the groundwater section of the  
22 water supply. The Agency does not wish to offer  
23 any testimony. However, if the Board has any  
24 questions, we can try to answer any questions you

1 may have.

2 MR. FOX: Very well, Ms. Olson.

3 Thanks very much. We certainly both on the part  
4 of the Board's technical staff and, of course, the  
5 Board members avail ourselves of Ms. Olson's  
6 offer to see if there are any questions on the  
7 Agency's information that is in the record.

8 Neither seeing nor hearing any,  
9 Ms. Olson. So I appreciate your willingness to do  
10 so, but I think we can move ahead. What I'd like  
11 to do before we briefly go off the record is  
12 see -- Mr. Mitchell, give you another chance to  
13 indicate if you have anything you'd like to offer  
14 into the record.

15 MR. MITCHELL: No.

16 MR. FOX: Very good. Why don't we  
17 go off the record in just a moment and plan to  
18 hold it open for about 15 minutes as I mentioned  
19 so that we can account for anyone who may be  
20 unavoidably delayed and during that time we can  
21 speak about the procedural issue and setting a  
22 deadline for post hearing comments and if we may  
23 go off the record then.

1 (Whereupon, a break was taken  
2 after which the following  
3 proceedings were had.)

4 MR. FOX: The time of 1:15 having  
5 arrived, we want to come back on the record. We  
6 have had no additional participants appear or  
7 indicate a willingness to attend the hearing  
8 either to offer testimony or comment and during  
9 the time that we were off the record the  
10 participants did discuss the procedural issue of  
11 setting a deadline for filing of post hearing  
12 comments.

13 The copies of the transcript of  
14 this hearing are expected to be available on or  
15 before Monday, September 26th, 2011. Of course,  
16 once it is filed with the Board, it will be posted  
17 promptly to the Board's website under the clerk's  
18 office online, or COOL. Based on the availability  
19 of the transcript, I expect to set a 14-day post  
20 hearing comment period expected to end on Monday,  
21 October 14th. However, once we have that  
22 transcript, I'll issue a Hearing Officer order so  
23 that every one -- all of the parties on the notice  
24 and the service lists are informed of the date on



1 which we received the transcript and the date on  
2 which we're setting the deadline for post hearing  
3 comments.

4 In addition to those comments,  
5 any person may file a written public comment on  
6 this rulemaking proposal with the Board's clerk.  
7 Comments may be filed electronically through COOL  
8 and questions on those procedures may be directed  
9 to our clerk's office. Any filings with the Board  
10 must also be served on the Hearing Officer and on  
11 those persons on the service list.

12 Again, the clerk's office can  
13 certainly provide any participant with the most  
14 recent version of that service list. If anyone  
15 has questions about the procedural aspects of this  
16 rulemaking, my contact information is listed on  
17 the Board's website. Are there any other matters  
18 that need to be addressed on the record? Mr.  
19 Mitchell, please go ahead.

20 MR. MITCHELL: Monday, October 10th.  
21 Not the 14th.

22 THE COURT: Thank you for correcting  
23 me. I often get dates wrong. That will be the --  
24 that's the expected conclusion of the 14-day

1 comment period. So thank you for setting me  
2 straight on that issue. Any other questions  
3 before we adjourn?

4 We have no other matters then to  
5 address and, again, no other participants have  
6 appeared indicating a willingness or interest in  
7 offering testimony. With that, thank you for your  
8 travel for this brief hearing and we are adjourned  
9 today. Thank you.
