
**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On October 5, 2011, a telephonic status conference was held. The complainant stated that since all of the missing and/or damaged flow restrictors have been replaced, it anticipates that it will file a motion to dismiss as to respondent Illinois Department of Transportation prior to the next status conference. Both respondent Village of Hinsdale and respondent DuPage County indicated that due in part to fiscal restraints they would not be participating in the Inter Governmental Agreement that was previously circulated for review. The Village of Hinsdale also stated that they are drafting a voluntary infrastructure master plan that addresses drainage issues. DuPage County may be filing a motion for enlargement of time regarding discovery within the next 21 days.

The Village of Hinsdale, along with Hinsdale Central High School, are scheduling a meeting with complainant in the near future to discuss a resolution in this matter.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on January 19, 2012, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. The complainant represented that it will notify the parties and the hearing officer of a call-in number prior to the next telephonic status conference. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


