ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.A. Holbrook):

On August 2, 2011, at the parties' request, the Board extended until October 24, 2011, the time period for Shell Oil Products U.S. (SOPUS) to appeal a June 16, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. In the determination, the Agency stated that the proposals addressing investigative activities associated with corrective action efforts for contaminated groundwater and free product could be approved with certain conditions and modifications stipulated by the Agency for the subject oil refinery, WRB Refining, LLC Wood River Refinery, located at 900 South Central Avenue, P.O. Box 76, Roxana, Madison County. Because SOPUS failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
