- 1 HEARING OFFICER ROBERTSON: Good
- 2 morning. My name is Daniel Robertson and I have
- been appointed by the board to serve as hearing
- 4 officer in this proceeding entitled In The Matter
- of Revision of Enhanced Vehicle Emission
- 6 Inspection and Maintenance Regulations:
- 7 Amendments to 35 Illinois Administrative Code Part
- 8 240. This is listed as R12-12 in the fourth
- 9 docket.
- With me today is the presiding board
- member Jennifer Burke. And to her left we have
- also been joined by Chairman Thomas Holbrook.
- 13 As stated at the first hearing, this
- 14 rulemaking was filed party pursuant to Section
- 15 13C-20A of the Vehicle Emissions Inspection Law of
- 2005; also stated as the VEIL of 2005. That
- section requires the board to adopt the rules
- within 120 days of receiving the agency's
- 19 proposal. And this proposal has appeared in the
- 20 Illinois Registrar on October 28th, 2011.
- Under Section 13C-20A of the VEIL of
- 2005; Section 27B of the Environmental Protection
- 23 Act; and the rulemaking provisions of the
- 24 Administrative Procedure Act or APA do not apply.

- 1 Accordingly, the board has not requested that the
- Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
- 3 conduct an economic impact study of this proposal.
- 4 The board also will not submit the proposal to
- first or second notice pursuant to Section 5-40 of
- 6 the APA. The board is however conducting these
- 7 two public hearings to solicit public comments.
- 8 The first hearing was held in Chicago on
- 9 November 17, 2011, where testimony from the
- proponent, the Illinois Environmental Protection
- 11 Agency, was heard. The purpose of today's hearing
- is to hear any additional testimony that anyone
- may wish to contribute. The filing deadline for
- 14 prefiled testimony was November 28th, 2011. And
- no filings were received by the board.
- During testimony please note that any
- question asked by a board member or staff is
