ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.A. Holbrook):

On October 20, 2011, the County of Macon (County) filed an administrative citation against Violet Gossett (respondent). *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108. The administrative citation concerns a property located at 4335 Neeley Avenue, Decatur, Macon County (site). The site is commonly known to the Macon County Environmental Management Department as the “Decatur/Violet Gossett” site and is designated with Land Pollution Control No. 1150155593. The County alleged that on September 23, 2011, respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1) and (p)(7) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(7) (2010)) by causing or allowing the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter and in deposition of general construction or demolition debris.

On December 14, 2011, the County filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the administrative citation. The Board grants the County’s motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.402.
