## **MOTION TO DISMISS**

Now comes the City of Joliet, by and through its attorneys, Drinker Biddle & Reath LLP, and hereby moves that the Pollution Control Board dismiss the above referenced matter.

In support of this Motion the City of Joliet states the following:

- 1. This matter was originally filed to request site specific relief regarding the discharge from the City of Joliet's ("Joliet") Eastside Waste Water Treatment Plant to Hickory Creek as envisioned in the March 30, 2007 Consent Order in the Circuit Court for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit in Will County, Illinois for case No. 05 CH 593 with the Illinois Attorney General and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("IEPA") because Joliet could not comply with its NPDES permit limits for fluoride and copper.
- 2 The IEPA issued a renewal of Joliet's NPDES Permit on May 23, 2008 which became effective on June 1, 2008 ("Renewed NPDES Permit"). This permit authorized Joliet to continue to discharge to Hickory Creek through outfall 001 and to the Des Plaines River through outfall 002 once Joliet completed construction of a new discharge. Because the flows in the Des Plaines River are much larger than flows in Hickory Creek, the Renewed NPDES Permit does not have a water quality based effluent limitation for fluoride and has a less restrictive limitation for copper for outfall 002.

3. On Monday, January 9, 2012, the effluent discharged from the Eastside Waste Water Treatment Plant was diverted to the newly constructed Des Plaines River Outfall and accordingly became subject to the effluent limitations set forth for outfall 002 in the Renewed NPDES Permit. Outfall 001 was then decommissioned and taken out of service. Flow cannot be returned to the old Hickory Creek outfall 001.

4. Because Joliet is in compliance with the Renewed NPDES Permit limitations applicable to outfall 002 and the limitations for outfall 001 are no longer applicable, there is no longer any reason to continue this matter.

WHEREFORE, the City of Joliet requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board dismiss this site specific rule proceeding.
