**Pollution Variance Notice**

On December 10, 2011, CITGO Petroleum Corporation and PDV Midwest Refining, L.L.C. ("Petitioners") located at 135th St. and New Avenue in Lemont, Illinois (Vill County) filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (the "Board") a petition for extension of its variance under Title IX of the Environmental Protection Act ("Act"). Variances may be granted pursuant to Section 35 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/35) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.

To assure continued compliance with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit, Petitioners request an extension of its variance from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.208(g) and 302.307, for Total Dissolved Solids ("TDS"). The Board granted Petitioners' initial variance on April 21, 2005. See in the Matter of: CITGO Petroleum Corp. and PDV Midwest Refining, L.L.C., PCB 05-95, April 21, 2005. The Board granted Petitioners subsequent variance in an order entered May 15, 2009. See Citgo Petroleum Corporation and PDV Midwest Refining, L.L.C. v. ILEPA, PCB 09-33.

Any person may request a hearing by filing with the Board a written objection to the grant of the variance, together with a written request for a hearing, within twenty-one (21) days after the publication of this Notice.

A copy of the variance petition is available from the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, James R. Thompson Center, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.

The Illinois EPA is preparing a recommendation regarding this variance petition. The Illinois EPA is to file its recommendation within forty-five (45) days after the filing of the petition. The Illinois EPA seeks the views of persons who may be adversely affected by the variance. A hearing may be held after the filing of the Illinois EPA recommendation. The record of this proceeding remains open for written comment for forty-five (45) days after filing of the Illinois EPA recommendation. Comments must be mailed to the Board at the above address for the Clerk of the Board.

The record in this variance proceeding is available at the Board's office for inspection, except those portions that are protected from disclosure under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 130. Procedures are available whereby disclosure may be sought by the public.
