ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On October 15, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Karco, Inc. (Karco) may appeal a September 6, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency required modifications to the site classification work plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 411 East Walnut Street in Murphysboro, Jackson County. The Board extends the appeal period until January 9, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Karco fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
