**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On April 5, 2012, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussions first centered on respondent's attorney John Murray's motion for leave to withdraw, filed on April 2, 2012.<sup>1</sup> The complainant stated that it had no objection to the motion. The motion was granted and the respondent was given to April 30, 2012, to retain another attorney.


It appears that the complainant has rejected respondent's ability to pay argument and, consequently, will proceed to discovery. To that end, a discovery schedule will be discussed at the next status conference.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on May 3, 2012, at 11:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


