JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That J&R Tire Service, Inc. is the current operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 27 N. Madison Street, Carthage, Hancock County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as J&R Tire Service, Inc.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0670250002.
 - 3. That Respondent has operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on April 11, 2012 Gerald McGhee, of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 5 3 12, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Gerald McGhee during the course of his April 11, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/55(k)(1)(2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>June 30, 2012</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each

violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Narrative

On April 11, 2012, I conducted a Tire Storage Inspection from 11:47 a.m. until 12:55 p.m. at J & R Tire Service located at 27 N. Madison Street in Carthage, Illinois. I interviewed Jeff Cole and Joe Cole. The facility is owned and operated by J & R Tire Service, Inc. (See Corporate Warranty Deed and Secretary of State's Corporation File Detail Report). The facility consists of two buildings on contiguous properties separated by an alley. The Used and/or Waste Tire Activity Notification Form has been submitted. I interviewed Jeff Cole and Joe Cole.

Joe Cole produced customer invoices showing that the Illinois Tire User Fee is being collected as a separate and distinct item apart from the selling price. He produced documents (ST-8) showing that the Fee is being submitted to the Illinois Department of Revenue as required. Jeff Cole produced receipts for disposal of a semi load of used tires on February 14, 2012.

I observed about 450 used tires stored inside the main building where sales and automotive maintenance takes place. (See photographs 1 through 8).

I observed about 50 used tires stored outside at the facility. Used tires stored outside are not prevented from accumulating water. Several large tires stored outside were holding a lot of water. Sampling revealed the presence of larval mosquitoes. (See photographs 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, and 18).

I observed about 150 used tires stored inside a second building that is used for storage only. See photographs 19 through 25.

The following apparent violations were observed:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 55(a)(3) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(a)(3)), no person shall, except at a tire storage site which contains more than 50 used tires, cause or allow the storage of any used tire unless the tire is altered, reprocessed, converted, covered, or otherwise prevented from accumulating water.
 - A violation of Section 55(a)(3) is alleged for the following reason: J & R Tire Service, Inc. allowed the storage of used tires that were not prevented from accumulating water.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 55(k)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(k)(1)), no person shall cause or allow water to accumulate in used or waste tires.
 - The prohibitions specified in this subsection (k) shall be enforceable by the Agency either by administrative citation under Section 31.1 of this Act or as otherwise provided by this Act.






