
**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On May 1, 2012, respondent DuPage County was given until May 8, 2012, to file its response to complainant's motion to dismiss respondent Illinois Department of Transportation from the complaint. DuPage County did not file a response and at the telephonic status conference orally stated that it has no objection to the motion and consequently will not file a response.

The complainant stated that it is holding individual settlement meetings with Village of Hinsdale and DuPage County within the next three weeks.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on July 26, 2012, at 11:45 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


