I object to Ameren's Petition for a Variance, Docket No. PCB 2012-126.

In 2006, Illinois made history by passing a leading mercury pollution reduction standard. The original agreement included new clean air standards for mercury, sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) and nitrous oxide (NO<sub>x</sub>), which create acid rain and smog, as well as many health-related problems. Ameren committed to a schedule for reducing its SO<sub>2</sub> and NO<sub>x</sub> pollution in return for more time to make its mercury pollution reductions.

The state upheld its side of the deal, but now Ameren is trying to stall cleaning up its coal plants like it promised to.
