ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On April 24, 2009, Ameren Energy Generating Company and Elgin Energy Center (Ameren) timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a March 19, 2009, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.302(e). The Agency's determination concerns Ameren's combustion turbines at the Elgin Energy Center, which is an electric generating station, located at 1559 Gifford Road, Elgin, Cook County. On October 11, 2012, Ameren filed a motion to dismiss this appeal. The motion indicates that a revised permit was issued and Ameren no longer seeks to appeal this permit decision. The motion is hereby granted and the docket is closed.
