2	MS. WEBB: Good morning, and welcome to this
3	Illinois Pollution Board hearing. My name is Carol
4	Webb, and I am acting today as the hearing officer
5	for this rulemaking proceeding entitled "In the
6	Matter of: Proposed Amendments to Special Waste
7	Hauling Permit Regulations to Implement Public Act
8	97-1081, 35 Illinois Administrative Code 809.204 and
9	809.212. The Board Docket Number for this rulemaking
10	is R13-8. Also present today from the board is
11	Chairman Tom Holbrook, the lead board member in this
12	proceeding, and Board Member Dr. Deanna Glosser.
13	The Illinois Pollution Control Board
14	initiated this rulemaking in an order dated September
15	20, 2012. The Board did so in response to Public Act
16	97-1081 effective August 24, 2012. One provision of
17	that Public Act amends Section 22.2(1) of the
18	Environmental Protection Act by extending the

- substantive merits. Those proposed amendments
- appeared in the Illinois Register on October 5, 2012,
- at 36 Illinois Register, page 14600.
- The first hearing took place on October
- 5 18, 2012, in Chicago. A hearing officer order set
- November 1, 2012, as the deadline to prefile
- 7 testimony for the second hearing, and no participant
- 8 has prefiled any testimony.
- 9 I will just take a moment right now to
- note that there are no members of the public here.
- We do have from the IEPA Ms. Kim Geving and Mr. David
- Walters who I understand is not here to testify but
- simply to answer any of the Board's questions or
- anybody else's questions, although there is no one
- else present.
- This proceeding is governed by the
- Board's procedural rules. Under Section 104.426 of
- the Board's procedural rules, all information that is
- relevant and that is not repetitious or privileged
- will be admitted into the record. Please note that
- any questions posed today by the Board and its staff
- are intended solely to assist in developing a clear
- and complete record for the Board's decision and do
- not reflect any prejudgment of the proposal.

- 1 There is nobody here who wishes to
- testify. I will ask the Board members on the record,
- do you have any questions that you would like to ask
- 4 the agency this morning?
- DR. GLOSSER: No, I don't.
- 6 CHAIRMAN. HOLBROOK: No, I don't.
- MS. WEBB: Okay, thank you. So let's move on
- 8 to the issue of an economic impact study. Section
- 9 27B of the Environmental Protection Act provides that
- the Board must request that the Department of
- 11 Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) conduct an
- economic impact study of proposed rules before the
- Board adopts the rules. The Board must make either
- the economic impact study, or the Department's
- explanation for not conducting one, available to the
- public at least 20 days before a public hearing.
- In a letter dated September 20, 2012,
- Chairman Tom Holbrook requested that DCEO conduct an
- economic impact study of this rulemaking proposal.
- The Board specifically requested a response no later
- than October 25, 2012. The Board has received no
- response from DCEO to this request.
- Is there anyone here who would like to
- testify or say anything regarding the economic impact

1 study?

(No response.)

Seeing no one who wishes to say anything

about anything at this hearing, we will just proceed

on to the final procedural issues.

Copies of this transcript are expected to be available at the Board, we are hoping, possibly by Monday, November 19. If our court reporter is able to get it in that quickly, that would be fantastic.

Once it is filed with the Board, the transcript will be posted promptly to the Board's website.

Before it takes action on the agency's proposal, the Board will hold open a post-hearing comment period ending Friday, November 30.
